DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:

1. Have someone read Psalm 139:23, 24. Have you ever prayed a bold prayer? Explain.
2. The prayer David prayed in Psalm 139, was a simple, yet profound prayer, that simply said, "Search me, O God, and know my heart." Have you ever prayed a prayer like David prayed? How can you learn from David's simple prayer?
3. Another powerful prayer that David prayed in Psalm 139 is, "Test me and know my anxious thoughts." How often do you have fearful thoughts? How do you handle your fearful thoughts?
 - a. What is it that internally makes you afraid?
 - b. Have you ever thought of opening that up to God?
 - c. Pastor said in his message, "What we fear the most reveals where we trust God the least." What do you think about that statement?
4. In Psalm 139:24(b) it says, "Lead me in the way everlasting." How does God lead you in the way everlasting? How can you trust God more during your journey through life?
5. What was the most meaningful statement, or scripture, you heard in this Sunday's message?
