#### **GETTING TO KNOW ME (ICEBREAKER):**

- If you had more free time, what hobby would you like to spend more time doing?

#### **DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:**

- Have someone read 2 Timothy 1:7. Share a time in your life that you were absolutely afraid.
- How much does imagination shape your life? Have someone read Proverbs 23:7 and Proverbs 4:23.
- Which are you more prone to – dread of failure, rejection, or calamity? What does that indicate about you?
- How does fear corrode our confidence in God’s goodness? How has it done so in your own life?
- The one statement Jesus made more than any other was this: “Don’t be afraid.”  
What does this tell you about human nature?
- Have someone read Matthew 8:23-27. What connection does Jesus make between fear and faith in verse 26?
- Have someone read 2 Timothy 1:7. What kind of spirit has God not given to his children?  
What kind of spirit has God given to his children? What difference should this make to us when fear strikes?
- What was the most meaningful statement or scripture, you heard in this Sunday’s message?
