“UNCOMMON HEROES” – MOSES PART 2

- Choose a few questions from the guide that will generate the most discussion in your group.

GETTING TO KNOW ME (ICEBREAKER):

- How did you celebrate Valentine’s Day?

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:

1. Have someone read Hebrews 11:24-25.
2. Moses had to deal with an identity crisis. Although he was raised in an Egyptian household, he was actually Jewish. How do you think his identity shaped his choices later in life?
3. The message emphasizes that maturity comes when we accept responsibility for our decisions. How does taking responsibility help us grow spiritually and emotionally?
4. Have you ever found yourself blaming others for challenges in your life? How can you start taking more responsibility for your choices?
5. Moses’ values were clearly established. He prioritized God’s purpose over the pleasures of Egypt. How do we determine our values in today’s world?
6. The message discusses how Moses kept his eyes on the goal and persevered. How can we focus on God’s calling when faced with distractions or challenges?
7. Have you ever struggled with waiting for God’s timing? What do you think the “Not yet” from God teaches us about patience and trust?
8. Reflecting on Moses’ life and choices, what is one area of your life where you need to say “no” to something temporary to say “yes” to God’s calling?
9. The message concludes with the challenge never to take your eyes off the goal. What is your current “goal” in life, and how can you focus on God as you pursue it?
