3. Have someone read Acts 1:8. According to this scripture, what do you need to be a witness in a complex world? How does the Holy Spirit help believers?
4. Have someone read Acts 2: 1-4. What stands out as the Holy Spirit makes an appearance in this scripture? How is the Spirit described in Acts 2: 1-2?
5. Pastor Seller’s said in his message, “The outward manifestation of “tongues” was the “indicator” of the inward infusion of a new power.” What do you think about that statement?
6. Pastor Seller’s said in his message, “The arrival of the Holy Spirit on the heels of Jesus’ ascension back to heaven was a total “game-changer” in so many ways.” How do you think the Holy Spirit is a game-changer in your life?
7. What was the most meaningful statement, or scripture, you heard in this Sunday’s message?
