GETTING TO KNOW ME (ICEBREAKER):

• Who are you going to invite to church on Easter Sunday?

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:

- 1. Have someone read John 12:13b. What does Palm Sunday represent in the Bible?
- 2. Reflecting on Romans 10:9, how would you explain the simplicity of salvation and the cost of following Jesus to someone seeking faith?
- 3. How have you personally experienced the support and encouragement of being part of the church family? How do you contribute to the spiritual growth of others in the church?
- 4. In 1 Peter 1:3, we are told that we are born again into God's family. How can we more intentionally embrace this privilege, especially in the context of our local church community?
- 5. How can you begin to act more like Christ in your day-to-day life? What practical steps can you take to model Christ's behavior in your work, relationships, and decisions?
- 6. Reflect on 2 Corinthians 5:19-20, where we are called to be Christ's ambassadors. What does it mean to represent Christ in your everyday life, especially in conversations with non-believers?
- 7. How can you be more intentional about sharing God's love with others, especially those who may not yet know Christ?
- 8. Think about one area of your life where you feel God calls you to be more committed. What steps can you take this week to move toward a more profound commitment?
- 9. How can we, as a small group, encourage each other in our commitments and hold each other accountable for living out our faith?
- 10. What are you struggling with in your commitment to Christ? How can the group pray for you in this area of your life?
