## **GETTING TO KNOW ME (ICEBREAKER):**

• Who do you think will win the men's and women's March Madness Tournament?

#### **DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:**

- 1. Have someone read Proverbs 3:22.
- 2. The message defines integrity as being "undivided, unseparated, and incorruptible." How does this definition of integrity challenge the way you view your life and relationships?
- 3. Proverbs 3:22 says, "The Lord hates people with twisted hearts, but He delights in those who have integrity." Why do you think God delights in those who live with integrity? How does this verse affect your perspective on honesty and consistency?
- 4. The message emphasized that integrity has a profound impact on those around you, particularly within your own home. How does living with integrity influence your relationships with family, friends, and coworkers? Can you think of a time when someone's integrity positively impacted you?
- 5. Proverbs 12:22 says, "The Lord hates liars but is pleased with those who keep their word." What challenges do you face when trying to speak the truth in your relationships? How can you be more intentional about keeping your word and being truthful?
- 6. 2 Corinthians 13:8 says, "Our responsibility is never to oppose the truth, but to stand for the truth at all times." In what situations have you struggled to stand for the truth, either personally or in your community? How can you grow in this area?
- 7. Philippians 2:15 encourages us to live clean, innocent lives as children of God in a crooked and perverse generation. How can we protect our integrity in a world full of temptations and moral compromises? What are some boundaries or safeguards you can put in place?
- 8. 1 Corinthians 15:33 says, "Bad company corrupts good character." How have your friendships influenced your integrity? What criteria do you use to choose friends who support your commitment to living with integrity?
- 9. Psalm 101:2-3 speaks about avoiding things that are "vile and vulgar." How does media consumption (movies, social media, etc.) impact your integrity? What steps can you take to protect your heart and mind from influences that might compromise your values?
- 10. 2 Peter 1:3 reminds us that God's divine power gives us everything we need for life and godliness. How can you rely more on Christ's strength to live a life of integrity, especially when it's difficult? What role do prayer and Scripture play in maintaining integrity?
