How important is it to know that God is with you?
3. Have someone read Judges 6:15 and Matthew 18:4. How can God use me? When God calls someone, He does not look at his appearance, physical strength, education, or unique ability. What do you think God looks at when He calls someone? Have someone read Romans 12:3.
4. Have someone read Judges 7:15. What does God desire from you? Is your heart ready to hear from God?
5. What was the most meaningful statement or scripture you heard in this Sunday's message?
