- Have someone read 1 Corinthians 16: 13-14. What are the five imperatives in this scripture? Do you find standing firm in different areas of your life difficult? Explain. In what areas of your life is it easier to stand firm?
- Dr. Hackett said in his message, “Courageous faith must stand firm in the face of the enemy.” How do you stand firm in the face of the enemy? Give an example.
- Dr. Hackett said in his message, “If I accept Jesus and His Kingdom, my kingdom needs to go.” What does that statement mean to you?
- Have someone read Psalms 73:23-26. Is there a time in your life when you experienced the hand of God guiding you? Explain.
