GETTING TO KNOW ME (ICEBREAKER):

• Name three things you love about the fall season.

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:

- Have someone read Ephesians 6. Why doesn't God just put supernatural protection around us so that we don't have to worry about the attacks of the enemy?
- How does Paul's emphasis on spiritual warfare shape your understanding of daily challenges?
- How can we apply the principles of mutual respect and love in our relationships, as seen in Ephesians 6:5-9?
- What do you think Paul means by "putting on the full armor of God"? How can we apply this metaphor in our daily lives?
- Have someone read 1 John 4:4. Who is that "He" that is in you? What does this scripture teach about the greatness of God?
- Which piece of the armor (truth, righteousness, peace, faith, salvation, and the Word of God) resonates with you the most right now? Why?
- In verse 18, Paul emphasizes the importance of prayer. How can we cultivate a deeper prayer life individually and as a group?
- · What are some ways we can support each other in spiritual battles or challenges we face in our lives?
- What was the most significant thing you learned from Sunday morning's message?
