- Choose a few questions from the guide that will generate the most discussion in your group.

GETTING TO KNOW ME (ICEBREAKER):

• What's one place in the world you'd love to visit — and if you could bring the hope of Jesus there, what would you want people to know about Him?

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:

- · Have someone read Matthew 28:18. What does it mean to live with Christ's authority in your everyday life?
- · Why do you think many Christians hesitate to walk in the authority Jesus has already given them?
- Have someone read Matthew 28:19. Dr. Wong came from a humble background, yet God used him in over 150 nations. What does this reveal about how God chooses and empowers His servants?
- Who are the "unreached" people right here in our community, and how can we begin reaching them?
- Have someone read Matthew 28:20. Why is it dangerous for churches to avoid difficult or unpopular parts of Scripture?
- Are there any biblical teachings you've personally struggled to accept or apply? What has helped (or could help) you grow in that area? How does knowing that Jesus is always with you change the way you face fear, share your faith, or make decisions?
- (Reflecting on the story of Graham Staines) What does the forgiveness shown by Gladys Staines teach us about the true power of the gospel?
- Dr. Wong said, "God is not asking you to die for Him; He's asking you to live for Him." What might living for Christ cost you personally, and what might it gain?
- What was the most significant thing you learned from Sunday morning's message?
