GETTING TO KNOW ME (ICEBREAKER):

• How are you going to celebrate Thanksgiving this year?

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:

- Have someone read Acts 1:8 and Acts 2:4.
- What does it mean to you personally that God has chosen "you" to be a witness? Why do you think God would entrust us with this mission?
- How does the idea that "you means everything" change the way we view our role in God's kingdom? In what ways does God's call feel personal and empowering to you?
- In what areas of your life do you struggle to believe that you are significant or capable of being used by God in His mission?
- Why do you think the Holy Spirit empowered the disciples in such a powerful way? How do you think this moment of empowerment challenged their understanding of what it meant to be a witness?
- How does obedience to the Holy Spirit's prompting play a role in witnessing? Are there times when you've felt challenged to obey even when it seemed uncomfortable or inconvenient?
- How does witnessing to people locally (Jerusalem) and globally (the ends of the earth) complement each other? Why do you think both are necessary in fulfilling the Great Commission?
- What was the most significant thing you learned from Sunday morning's message?
