DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:

- Have someone read Ephesians 3:16-19.
- What does it mean to be "rooted and grounded in love," as Paul prays in Ephesians 3:17?
 How can we experience and comprehend the vastness of Christ's love in our daily lives?
- How can we allow God's love to fill us "to the fullness of God"? What might that look like practically in our relationships and interactions with others?
- Jesus challenges us to love beyond the ordinary by loving those who love us back (Luke 6:32). How does this challenge how we often think about love?
- Can you think of a time when you loved someone without expecting anything in return? How did it impact you or your relationship with that person?
- How does loving others make us more receptive to God's love? How can giving love to others help us grow spiritually?
- In what areas of your life do you feel challenged to freely give and receive love more openly?
 Why is it sometimes difficult to accept love from others?
- What are some practical ways we can reflect God's love in our daily lives, especially when it's difficult?
- What was the most significant thing you learned from Sunday morning's message?
