- Pray for your group discussion time!
- Choose a few questions from the guide that will generate the most discussion in your group.

GETTING TO KNOW ME (ICEBREAKER):

- If you could have anyone in the world be “for you” and cheering you on this week, who would it be and why?

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:

- Romans 8:31 says, “If God is for us, who can be against us?”
What situation in your life right now would look different if you truly believed God is for you?
- F.F. Bruce describes God as the Judge who has already pronounced “acquittal and justification.”
How does this image shift the way you think about guilt, shame, or spiritual accusations?
- Romans 8:34 and Hebrews 7:25 say that Jesus is continually interceding for us.
What do you think it means for Jesus to pray for you personally?
- In Luke 22:31–32, Jesus tells Peter, “But I have prayed for you.”
When have you gone through something difficult and only later realized God carried you through it?
- According to Romans 8:35–39, nothing can separate us from Christ’s love.
Which of the listed threats (fear, worry, danger, hardship, etc.) most often makes you feel distant from God—even though Scripture says you’re not?
- How do you personally remind yourself of God’s unshakeable love during seasons of fear, doubt, or discouragement?
- Romans 8:37 says we are “more than conquerors.”
What do you think it practically means to live as “more than a conqueror” in everyday life?
- George Eliot said, “It’s never too late to become the person you could have been.”
How does God’s love and power give you hope for personal growth or transformation?
