- Choose a few questions from the guide that will generate the most discussion in your group.

## **GETTING TO KNOW ME (ICEBREAKER):**

• What are you most thankful for this Thanksgiving?

### **DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:**

- Have someone read Ezekiel 37:1-14.
- Have you ever experienced a situation where you felt like your circumstances were "dead" or beyond repair? What did that look like to you?
- What are some common ways that hopelessness shows up in our lives (e.g., relationships, careers, faith)?
- What do you think is significant about God asking Ezekiel, "Can these bones live?" and then telling him to prophesy to the bones?
- In verse 7, Ezekiel obeys God's command and speaks to the bones. What role does obedience to God's word play in seeing a change in hopeless situations?
- What are some ways you can speak life into your current struggles or areas that seem "dead" or hopeless?
- The prophecy brings life back to the bones. In what ways does this passage speak to the possibility of spiritual, emotional, or relational restoration?
- As we reflect on this passage, is there a specific "dead" area in your life that you feel God is calling you to trust Him with?
- How can this restoration story inspire you to share hope with someone feeling spiritually dry or hopeless?
