AS THE DISCUSSION LEADER, THERE ARE A FEW THINGS TO KEEP IN MIND FOR YOUR SMALL GROUP:

- Pray for your group discussion time!
- Choose a few questions from the guide which you feel will generate the most discussion in your group.

GETTING TO KNOW ME (ICEBREAKER):

- What plans have you made for Spring?

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:

- Have someone read Luke 8:4-15. How can I hear God speak to me? Does God speak to people today?
- Have someone read Philippians 2:13. What does this verse reveal to you about God?
- God speaks by the Holy Spirit through the bible, prayer, circumstances, and the church to reveal Himself, His purposes, and His ways. How has God spoken to you lately?
- God’s goal is to reveal Himself to people to draw them into a love relationship with Himself. His ways are redemptive. He acts in a way that reveals Himself and His love. Have someone read Isaiah 55:8. Why does God reveal His ways?
- Pastor said in his message, “God wants to speak to you, but the condition of your heart determines whether you hear Him speak or not.” Here are four that Pastor mentioned:
 - o Cultivate an open heart.
 - o I must allocate time to listen.
 - o Eliminate the distractions.
 - o Cooperate with what God says.
- Out of the four conditions listed above which one/s do you need to make a priority to correct?
- Have someone read 1 Corinthians 2:9. Can you see this verse lived out in your life? Explain.
- What was the most meaningful statement, or scripture, you heard in this Sunday’s message?
