March 1989 - Held first service at Southeastern Chapel with 800 people.

June 1989 - Voted Blackburns in as Senior Pastor.

February 1990 - Began construction on Family Life Center.

June 1990 - Initiated first mission trip to Tela, Honduras.

October 1990 - Held first service in new Family Life Center.

August 1993 - Began Kids Club Sidewalk ministry, reaching inner city kids.

October 1993 - Opened new Family Life Center classroom wing.

September 1994 - Launched Kidz Life preschool.

October 1995 - Burned mortgage on Family Life Center.

November 1996 - Acquired another 23 acres of adjacent land on west side.

March 1997 - Occupied new Family Life Center early childhood wing.

August 1997 - Launched Victory Christian Academy, beginning with Kindergarten.

February 1998 - Began construction of new sanctuary.

June 1998 - Began Circle J Camps for inner city kids at Cheyenne Territory.

October 1999 - Occupied new sanctuary, with approximately 3,000 in attendance.

March 2003 - Dedicated newly constructed Light of Lights Chapel.

March 2006 - Opened South Campus in the Cobb Theatres at Lakeside Village.

August 2006 - Opened Victory Christian Academy High School.

June 2011 - Started Dream Center ministry, reaching Lakeland's inner city.

September 2014 - Began Small Groups.

March 2019 - Celebrated 30 year anniversary of Victory Church.

HOW SMALL GROUPS WORK

God designed us for relationships; we were never intended to do life alone. We believe that through the intentional connections made in Small Groups that we grow in our walk with Christ. Victory Church has many Small Groups meeting weekly in homes across Lakeland and the surrounding area for people in every stage of life. These groups gather to encourage one another, discuss what is being taught from the Bible on Sunday, pray together, and push each other to go deeper in their walk with Christ. With so many amazing groups to choose from, we know that there is a group with which you can do life!

Four things to know about Victory Small Groups:

1. Our groups are either message-based or curriculum-based.

The Bible teaches that our new life in Christ flows from the power of God's Word. Some groups focus their discussions directly from the messages that are preached on Sunday mornings. This helps us internalize and apply what we have learned.

Other groups might center around the things you are already doing in your life. From sports groups to lunch groups, parenting groups to student groups, Bible study groups to creative arts groups, our groups are as varied as we are.

2. We have three sessions every year.

Life is seasonal, so small groups at Victory are geared to flow with these seasons. Our groups meet in the fall, winter, and spring; with the summer off.

3. You can join a group.

VICTORY CHURCH GOVERNMENT

Believers who invest their heart, time, family and finances in the building of a local church deserve to have confidence in church leadership. People are looking for leaders to conduct themselves with integrity and respect when making decisions that affect their lives.

Our Church Government

The Lead Pastor is the spiritual overseer of the Church and directs its activities. He is the President of the Corporation and acts as Chairman of all business meetings and the meetings of the Church Board. He selects his ministerial and administrative staff and determines their job portfolio.

The Church Board serves the Church as fiduciary custodians and acts in an advisory capacity, assisting the Lead Pastor in all matters pertaining to the Church in its spiritual life and in the ministry of its ordinances.

The Church Members serve as the voting body to prayerfully elect the Lead Pastor and Church Board Members when there are vacancies. They also vote on all borrowing and property acquisitions.
