YOU ARE AGREEING THAT, EVEN IF PENINSULAR FLORIDA DISTRICT COUNCIL OF THE ASSEMBLIES OF GOD USES REASONABLE CARE IN PROVIDING THIS ACTIVITY, THERE IS A CHANCE YOUR CHILD MAY BE SERIOUSLY INJURED OR KILLED BY PARTICIPATING IN THIS ACTIVITY BECAUSE THERE ARE CERTAIN DANGERS INHERENT IN THE ACTIVITY WHICH CANNOT BE AVOIDED OR ELIMINATED. BY SIGNING THIS FORM YOU ARE GIVING UP YOUR CHILD'S RIGHT AND YOUR RIGHT TO RECOVER FROM PENINSULAR FLORIDA DISTRICT COUNCIL OF THE ASSEMBLIES OF GOD IN A LAWSUIT FOR ANY PERSONAL INJURY, INCLUDING DEATH, TO YOUR CHILD OR ANY PROPERTY DAMAGE THAT RESULTS FROM THE RISKS THAT ARE A NATURAL PART OF THE ACTIVITY. YOU HAVE THE RIGHT TO REFUSE TO SIGN THIS FORM, AND PENINSULAR FLORIDA DISTRICT COUNCIL OF THE ASSEMBLIES OF GOD HAS THE RIGHT TO REFUSE TO LET YOUR CHILD PARTICIPATE IF YOU DO NOT SIGN THIS FORM.

By signing this form, I affirm that the information submitted online is true and accurate to the best of my knowledge. I do hereby state that I have legal custody of this child, a minor, who resides with me. While this minor is a registered camper at any Peninsular Florida Assemblies of God summer camp, I hereby authorize any director, counselor, nurse, dean, lifeguard, or other responsible person of said Camp to consent to any x-ray, examination, anesthetic, medical or surgical treatment, and hospital care, to be rendered to this minor under the general or special supervision and on the advice of any physician or surgeon licensed to practice in the United States, when such medical or surgical treatment is necessary. I understand that should such treatment be necessary that the Peninsular Florida Assemblies of God summer camp provides only *secondary* insurance, and begins where the camper's primary health and accident insurance policy has been extended to its limits. I understand that every effort will be made to contact me regarding any medical attention given to my child.

I also understand that participants at Masterpiece Gardens Camp are liable for damage caused intentionally or maliciously. Damage caused by a participant will be billed directly to the participant responsible and their legal guardian. I understand that youth camp is a voluntary activity. Student must be willing to cooperate with the overall spirit and schedule of the camp. Finally, I understand that every effort will be made to room church groups in the same dorms. However, due to the structure of camp and limited number of beds, this is not always possible.

Over the counter meds such as Tylenol, Midol, and multi-vitamins must all be turned in to the first aid director.

IMPORTANT 2022 KIDS CAMP INFORMATION FOR PARENTS

Please read the following information and review the camp policies and what to wear with your child.

CHECK-IN / CHECK-OUT Bus will leave from Victory Church at 9AM on Monday July 25. Please arrive by 8:30AM to load the bus, pray, and do final lice check. Lunch will be served on the first day at 12:30PM. Check-out time on the last day of camp is 10AM and bus will return to Victory Church around 11AM on Friday July 29. Please be ready to pick up your child at that time.

CAMP AGE Both weeks are for students entering grade 3 thru 7 for the 2022-23 school year.

MEALS Meal times will be at 8AM, 12:30PM, and 5:30PM. The Shack (snack bar) will be open 2 times a day in case campers would like some candy or sodas, so you may choose to send \$3-5 per day for concessions. A Camp Bank & Snack Shack cards will be provided to safeguard money. *No lunch will be served on Friday.*

DIETARY RESTRICTIONS Unfortunately, because we order our items in bulk, we are unable to order in food for special diets. Attendees with **special diets only** are more than welcome to bring food that can be microwaved or eaten cold to supplement what we serve. Refrigerated space and a microwave can be provided and accessed during meals. We can also store items in the freezer for them and bring them to them for a meal when requested. We are unable to cook and prepare food brought to camp. Menus can be obtained for review and space set aside PRIOR TO CAMP by emailing masterpiececamp@aol.com.

CAMP REGISTRATION FEES The price of camp includes: registration, tuition, lodging, meals and secondary insurance. If the registration process is not completed prior to the early deadline, add \$25 for the full price. There will be no extensions. We strongly recommend early pre-registration. There is limited space at our facility, and the state will not permit an overflow position. The only way to guarantee your space is to pre-register. Any transfer of funds – other than the deposit - from one student to another must be done in advance and not on-site.

PRE-REGISTRATION No phone registrations or partial registrations will be accepted. Only a deposit with a completed registration and camper consent & agreement form will hold a spot. Students or groups registering by the early registration deadline must pay the correct deposit amount to be eligible for the early registration pricing.

REFUNDS Due to programming costs, refunds for students who are unable to attend a full week of camp will be issued at the end of the camping season minus the non-refundable, non-transferable deposit of \$50. We cannot refund monies for partial attendance to a week of camp. No refunds will be given for expelled students.

WAITING LIST Many camps fill up. If you pre-register and the camp is already over capacity you will be contacted and placed on a waiting list. Any cancellations will result in those beds being given to campers on the waiting list. Forfeited beds cannot automatically be claimed by new campers on registration day. Registration funds will be refunded if a bed is not available.

LICE POLICY Due to very close living conditions, major disruptions occur when there is a health problem. Lice is nearly impossible to treat in a dorm community such as camp. If a student is found to have lice, we will have to ask that they be picked up from camp, treated, and be nit free for 24-hours before returning to camp. It is recommended that these situations be monitored before leaving for camp. All camps will have complete checks before registration takes place. Please help us avoid embarrassing situations of having to either not admit or send a camper home.

MEDICATION / SPECIAL MEDICAL REQUESTS Please be sure to fully complete the *PFYouth Camper Medication Form* on which you must list all medications your child will be bringing and any special needs the First Aid Director should be made aware of. **We cannot administer meds without a fully completed medication form.** *The Camper Medical Form is to be placed in a Ziploc bag with the medications and submitted to the First Aid Director on the first day of camp.*

HOUSING All students will be assigned to dormitory style rooms before arriving on the campgrounds on a first come first serve basis. Add-ons cannot be guaranteed to be housed with their group. We will do our best to accommodate housing requests, but with NO GUARANTEES! If the camp reaches capacity you will be offered another week to attend if available. Hotel options are **not** available for Kids Camps.

NON-CAMPER POLICY PFYouth summer camps are CLOSED camps. All camp activities including evening services are open only to registered campers and staff. Any child, student or adult violating this policy will be asked to leave the grounds.

LOST & FOUND Any lost and found items left on grounds after the conclusion of camp will be held for one month. If not claimed during that time period, they will be given away. Items will be shipped back to their owners at their owners' expense.

CAMP PROPERTY DAMAGE Charges for items broken/damaged during camp will be billed to all parties/individuals involved.

CAMP POLICIES By registering for camp, you agree to abide by all rules set forth by the Pen Florida District Council of the Assemblies of God, Masterpiece Gardens Campground, and the District Youth Director. Policies are given as guidelines for every camper to follow. This code of conduct has been established for your student's protection and the benefit of every person present. The lack of cooperation, unnecessary roughness, lack of respect for property, or an unwholesome attitude on the part of any camper will result in expulsion from camp. The expense of transporting the expelled camper(s) home from camp is the responsibility of the parents/guardians.

- We should strive at all times to conduct ourselves as Christian ladies and gentlemen with proper consideration shown for others.
- Attendance at all scheduled activities is compulsory.
- Room and grounds must be kept clean. Take care of property. Campers are responsible to pay for damage to dorms and camp property. Should an offender not be found, the dorm room members will be charged equally.
- Campers must be in bed and quiet at "lights out."
- Campers are not to enter another dorm without the counselor's permission.
- Due to security issues, we have a closed camp.
- No camper shall be allowed to leave the grounds or go out of bounds without proper permission from a camp executive.
- No fireworks, firearms, tobacco (including e-cigarettes, vapes, or juuls), alcohol, drugs, airsoft or paintball guns, improper reading materials, or pets will be allowed on the grounds.
- Lockers are provided in each room. Campers wishing to provide additional security may bring their own padlocks. Such locks are not provided by the camp or staff. Campers agree that their property may be checked if there is suspicion of theft or improper material.
- No excessive practical joking. Hazing and destruction of property will result in dismissal from camp.
- Bullying. Zero tolerance for bullying. Immediate dismissal of students bullying other students.

WHAT TO BRING

- Towels & Wash Cloths
- Soap, Toothbrush, Toothpaste, Shampoo, Hairdryer

- Water Bottle (refillable with name clearly marked)
- Modest swimwear
- Spending money for snacks & camp store
- Dirty Clothes Bag

Please clearly label all items. Campers are responsible for personal belongings. PFYouth is not responsible for lost/stolen items.

WHAT NOT TO BRING No electric devices, laptops, video games, Silly String, shaving cream, water guns, water balloons, tape, spray paint products. We encourage you NOT to bring cell phones, iPods, etc. If they are used during the service or planned activities, they will be secured by our staff.

WHAT TO WEAR

- *Abbreviated Attire* such as half shirts, backless or halter-type dresses or shirts, spaghetti straps or extremely tight garments will not be allowed by campers or staff.
- Shoes must be worn at all times – including to and from the pool.
- Shorts of modest length may be worn
- Bathrobes or a large towel must be worn over bathing suits to and from the pool. Guys, this includes you. T-shirt to cover chest must be worn to and from pool.
- Recreation during the day is often messy. Keep this in mind when you are planning what clothes to bring. You will want to bring older clothes and shoes that you can get wet, muddy and generally dirty. Ladies may want to wear a bathing suit under their clothing or a dark colored t-shirt for recreation.
- Pajamas are NOT allowed for recreation activities.
- If a camper's clothing is deemed inappropriate they will be asked to change.
